Safety Checklist

- We regularly talk to our employees about safety
- We encourage the reporting of safety concerns
- Employees report safety concerns
- We have a near hit reporting system in place
- Employees report near hits
- We have a properly developed, complete safety management program in place
- Our employees know and understand our safety management program
- We audit our program regularly to check its effectiveness
- We treat our safety management programs as a living document and change it when required
- We track our safety efforts using company data sources and share the results with our workers
- We regularly do a job hazard safety analyses before any work begins
- we perform risk assessments before work begins
- we regularly inspect our workplace to identify safety hazards and problems
- we fix identified hazards and problems
- We orient our new employees
- We train our employees to know the hazards of their workplace and how to work safely around those hazards
- We insist that all work is carried out safely
- We have a discipline policy that we use when workers refuse to work safely
- Safety is a value of our company, therefore it is never compromised
- Safety is a priority at our company and therefore it can be ranked as more or less important depending on other factors such as project costs and pressure to complete the job *
